

POTTY TRAINING

(Only complete this form if your child is not toilet trained.)

What does it mean to be toilet trained?

Your child is able to communicate the need to use the restroom facilities, knowledge of how to flush the toilet and wash their hands. All children should be able to wipe themselves after using the restroom. If your child has more than three non-naptime accidents in a four week period you will be required to pay the monthly diaper changing fee until your child is toilet trained.

Diaper Changing Fees—Non PDO Classes

3 Years old \$75 Monthly

4 Years old \$150 Monthly

5 Years old \$200 Monthly
